The Vatican has designated the Feast of Our Lady of Lourdes, Feb. 11, as the World Day of the Sick. Daniel Cardinal DiNardo will celebrate an Anointing Mass at the Co-Cathedral of the Sacred Heart on Wednesday, Feb. 11, 2009, at 7 p.m. Archbishop Emeritus Joseph A. Fiorenza, Auxiliary Bishop Joe S. Vasquez and Auxiliary Bishop Emeritus Vincent M. Rizzotto along with more than 30 priests from our diocese will concelebrate the Mass. All members of our diocese are invited to attend the Mass. If you plan to attend and receive the Sacrament of the Sick, please call your Parish Office to let them know you will be in attendance and how many others will be with you. Parishes are asked to fax their totals to the Office of Worship.

January 22—A Day of Prayer and Penance for Life In all the dioceses of the United States of America, January 22 (or January 23, when January 22 falls on a Sunday) shall be observed as a particular day of penance for violations to the dignity of the human person committed through acts of abortion, and of prayer for the full restoration of the legal guarantee of the right to life. The Mass "For Peace and Justice" (no. 22 of the "Masses for Various Needs") should be celebrated with violet vestments as an appropriate liturgical observance for this day.
