**WORD OF LIFE**

"If the election is misinterpreted ideologically as a referendum on abortion, the unity desired by President-elect Obama and all Americans at this moment of crisis will be impossible to achieve. Abortion kills not only unborn children; it destroys constitutional order and the common good, which is assured only when the life of every human being is legally protected. Aggressively pro-abortion policies, legislation and executive orders will permanently alienate tens of millions of Americans, and would be seen by many as an attack on the free exercise of their religion."



**STEWARDSHIP: A WAY OF LIFE**

There is a certain urgency in today's Gospel as Jesus calls His first disciples—Andrew and Simon, James and John. Each one follows Jesus immediately, unhesitatingly abandoning nets and boats and father and fellow-workers. To what is Jesus calling me—at this moment, in these circumstances? What will I need to abandon in order to follow Him?

"The Pauline Year is a year of pilgrimage, not only in the sense of an external journey towards places associated with St Paul, but also, and above all, in the sense of a pilgrimage of the heart, together with Paul towards Jesus Christ. In a word, Paul teaches us that the Church is the Body of Christ, that the Head and the Body are inseparable and that there can be no love for Christ without love for his Church and her living community."



**ADMINISTRACION CRISTIAN: MANERA DE VIVIR:**

En una palabra, Pablo nos enseña que la Iglesia es el Cuerpo de Cristo, que la Cabeza y el Cuerpo son inseparables y que no puede haber amor sin el amor de Cristo a su Iglesia y su comunidad de vida."
