WORD OF LIFE

Sexually active teenage girls (aged 14 to 17) are over 3 times more likely to be depressed than girls who are not sexually active and almost 3 times more likely to attempt suicide than their sexually inactive counterparts. One survey found that 72% of sexually active teenage girls (aged 12 to 17) wish they had waited longer before beginning sexual activity.

PALABRA DE VIDA

Las adolescentes (de 14 a 17 años de edad) sexualmente activas son por encima de tres veces mas probables de estar deprimidas en comparación con las adolescentes que no lo son, y casi tres veces mas probables de intentar suicidarse comparadas con sus pares que no lo son. Una encuesta hallo que el 72% de las adolescentes sexualmente activas (de 12 a 17 años de edad) desean haber esperado mas tiempo antes de comenzar a tener relaciones sexuales.
