## **MASS HONORING THOSE WITH DISABILITIES**

Thirty years ago this November, the bishops of the United States called upon each of us to recognize the face of Christ in persons who have disabilities. The 1978 Pastoral statement of U.S. Catholic Bishops on People with Disabilities describes how we can and should include people with disabilities into the full life of the Church. Our Holy Father called us to draw near to "Christ Our Hope" during his visit to the United States. Throughout this 30th anniversary year, let us "Live Christ Our Hope," as we honor the gifts that people with disabilities bring to their faith communities, and rededicate ourselves to ensuring their meaningful participation in all aspects of the Church and society. In honor this occasion, Cardinal DiNardo will preside at a Mass on Wednesday, November 19th at 6:30 p.m., at St. Theresa (Houston). A reception will follow. Everyone is invited to attend.
