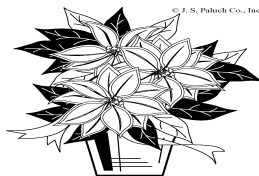


ADMINISTRACION CRISTIAN: MANERA DE VIVIR:

WORD OF LIFE

This teaching (condemning abortion) has consequences for those charged with caring for the common good, those who hold public office. The unborn child, who is alive and is a member of the human family, cannot defend himself or herself. Good law defends the defenseless. Our present laws permit unborn children to be privately killed. Laws that place unborn children outside the protection of law destroy both the children killed and the common good, which is the controlling principle of Catholic social teaching. One cannot favor the legal *status quo* on abortion and also be working for the common good. This explains why the abortion issue will not disappear and why it is central to the Church's teaching on a just social order.

PALABRA DE VIDA

Esta enseñanza (que condena el aborto) tiene consecuencias para quienes tienen la responsabilidad de velar por el bien común, quienes tienen un cargo público. El niño por nacer, que esta vivo y es miembro de la familia humana, no puede defenderse a si mismo. La buena ley defiende a los indefensos. Nuestras leyes actuales permiten matar en forma privada a los niños por nacer. Las leyes que ponen a los niños por nacer fuera de la protección de la ley destruyen a los niños asesinados y el bien común, que es el principio guía de la Doctrina Social Católica. No se puede favorecer el *status quo* jurídico sobre el aborto y también trabajar por el bien común. Esto explica por que el problema del aborto no desaparecerá y por que es importante para la enseñanza de la Iglesia sobre un orden social justo.
