### Word of Life

Faith teaches us that we are God's creatures, made in his image and likeness, endowed with an inviolable dignity, and called to eternal life. Wherever man is diminished, the world around us is also diminished; it loses its ultimate meaning and strays from its goal. That emerges is a culture, not of life, but of death. How could this be considered "progress"? It is a backward step, a form of regression which ultimately dries up the very sources of life for individuals and all of society.

### Palabra de Vida

Thirty years ago this November, the bishops of the United States called upon each of us to recognize the face of Christ in persons who have disabilities. The 1978 Pastoral statement of U.S. Catholic Bishops on People with Disabilities describes how we can and should include people with disabilities into the full life of the Church. Our Holy Father called us to draw near to "Christ Our Hope" during his visit to the United States. Throughout this 30th anniversary year, let us "Live Christ Our Hope," as we honor the gifts that people with disabilities bring to their faith communities, and rededicate ourselves to ensuring their meaningful participation in all aspects of the Church and society. In honor of this occasion, Cardinal DiNardo will preside at a Mass on Wednesday, November 19th at 6:30 p.m., at St. Theresa (Houston). A reception will follow. Everyone is invited to attend.

A lo largo de estos treinta años podemos decir "Viva Cristo Nuestra Esperanza", a la vez que honramos los dones que las personas con discapacidad aportan a sus comunidades de fe, y dedicamos a asegurar su participación significativa en todos los aspectos de la Iglesia y la sociedad. Por lo tanto, en honor de esta ocasión, el Cardenal DiNardo presidirá una Misa el miércoles, 19 de noviembre a las 6:30 p.m. en la parroquia de Santa Teresa (Houston). Acto seguido por una recepción. Todos están invitados.
